




Customers agree to hold Outdoor Living Today and any Authorized Dealers free of any liability for improper installation, maintenance and repair of any Outdoor Living Today products.




Regular Maintenance & Tips to Prolong the Life of your Canopy.



Care and Maintenance:

- Do not leave canopy extended during heavy snow storms or any extreme weather conditions.
- Reasonable care should be taken to remove accumulated dirt and debris in track.
- Canopy Tracks may have sharp corners. Always use gloves when handling to prevent cuts.
- Lubrication (supplied in kit) of wing wheels and track should be done annually.
- Wing and canopy can be removed seasonally to improve longevity. Check Wheels and Axle to ensure proper working order. Do not operate if cracked or broken. Call OLT for replacement.
- Check Track Screws for wear annually. Remove and replace any screws showing excessive wear.
- To keep the Harbor-Time canopy fabric looking clean and bright, wash periodically with a soft brush, warm water and mild soap. Do not use detergent.
- 5 year limited manufacturer's warranty on the Harbor-Time canopy fabric.



Important: Once your pergola and retractable canopy have been correctly installed, do a water test to confirm water is draining properly from the canopy. *To perform a water test* spray some water onto the high side of your canopy to ensure water drains off the low side.

Please contact us immediately if large amounts of water remain in each fabric fold when extended. The Canopy is designed to hold several gallons of water per fold. If more than a gallon of water is collecting in each fold, keep the canopy closed until a solution is found. Failure to do so could void your warranty.

Troubleshooting:

Water Not Draining From Canopy

Possible Causes:

- Canopy Fabrics needs more drop. If fabrics are too tight when extended, water will not drain properly. Try lowering anchor knobs on both ends to increase fabric drop.
- Slope of Canopy not steep enough. Pergola could be sloped the wrong direction. A deeper Lowering Cleat may be required.

Canopy Not Rolling Back and Forth Smoothly on Tracks Possible Causes:

- Tracks and Wheels need to be Lubricated.
- Check Track to confirm it is straight. Bend or move track to straigten if possible.
- Mounting Track fasteners are impeding wheels. Check and adjust if necessary.

Custom Retractable Canopy Parts List



1 1/4" Brown Wood Screws -For Wing Stop



1 1/2" Torx Screws -For Tracks




4" Torx Screws For Lowering Cleat (if required)



A - Canopy Lowering Cleat - Various Quantities.

- 1 1/2" x Various widths - Various Lengths (May be required depending on pergola)




B - Canopy Tracks - 2 to 4 Pcs. (depending on canopy pull length)



D - Aluminum Wing Stops (2 variations) With/without Wood Stop in end.

4 1/4" Long- 2 Pcs. 2 drill holes.



4" long x 1/4" diameter Plastic Rail Connector -2 Pcs. (Only supplied if two tracks/side required.)



C - Aluminum Wings with Fabrics attached. (With Plastic Wheel attached to each Wing end.)

H - Track Brace (HS) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Counter Sunk 1 1/2"

(May be required depending on pergola)

G - Track Braces (LS) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" Counter Sunk 2" (May be required depending on pergola)



F- Canopy Pull Handle



E- Wing Anchor Knobs - 3 Pcs.



Torx Drive Bit 1 Pc.

1/4" Drill Bit 1 Pc.

Track Lubricant - 1 Bottle.





Installation of the OLT Retractable Canopy couldn't be easier. Just 4 Easy Steps!







1. Canopy track must be lower on one side. If your pergola requires Lowering Cleats, install now. With a Step Ladder, install Part A - Canopy Lowering Cleats - 3 pcs Total. Attach with 2-3 - 4" Torx Screws. Cleats will lower the canopy on one side and drain water off the fabric so it doesn't collect excessively. Decide best side for water to drain for your situation. Position cleats underneath pergola joists or blocking as shown above and attach. Cleats are pre-drilled for Torx Screws.




1a. If your Canopy Packing List includes **Part G - Low Side Track Braces**, attach them directly under joist and flush against Girder. Brace is counter sunk. Attach with 2 - 4" screws.




1b. If your Canopy Packing List includes additional **Part G - Low Side Track Braces** and **Part A - Canopy Lowering Cleats**, attach them to the bottom of the first layer of **Part G** and **Part A**.





1C. If your Canopy Packing List includes **Part H - High Side Track Braces**, install them on the opposite side of Part A & Part G (install on high side of canopy). Attach directly under Joist and flush against Girder. Braces are counter sunk. Attach with 2 - 2 1/2" Screws per piece.



2. With Step Ladders and assistance, lift up **Part B - Canopy Track** and position against post and tight to the underside of pergola joist on side (use side without lowering cleats first). Align track against post. Attach track to post with 1 - 1/2" Torx Screw. Drill hole in track with 1/4" drill provided. On opposite end of track, screw 1 - 1 1/2" Torx Screw up through the track into bottom of wood joist. Attach 4 more 1 1/2" Torx Screws evenly spaced along the the track into the bottom of joist.










4. Prior to feeding Part C - Aluminum Wings and Canopy into track, locate Lubricant in Hardware Pack and apply a small amount to top of each wheel. Spin wheel slowly to lubricate entire surface. Lubricate all wheels.

Alternate Canopy Configuration.









5. Before feeding Part C - Aluminum Wings with Canopy into track, make sure canopy fabric is facing the correct direction. First, locate Lead and Anchor Wings in set. Both have a black pull rope attached. Make sure rope knots are facing to the inside and the pull rope is facing to the outside. Starting with the Lead Wing, feed the wing wheels onto the track as shown above. Wheels have springs and compress in and out slightly to fit. Feed wings in the track that is open on the end (gap side) first.


Important- Ensure rope knots are on the top side of the canopy, facing the center of the pergola so that pull rope is accessible.

You will need 2 Ladders and a helper to feed the wings into track.







6. Push Lead Wing slightly ahead on track. Wings can roll out of track until **Part D - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Aluminum Wing Stops** are installed so be careful. Lift and feed 2nd Wing into track and push wing slightly forward.



8. Install **Part D - 4 1/2" long Aluminum Wing Stops - 2 Pcs.** where track ends and gap exists. Use 2 - 1 1/4" brown screws per stop to install. When removing the wings and canopy in the future, simply remove wing stops and roll wing and canopy out carefully with a helper.





10. With canopy pull handle or on a ladder using your hand, pull anchor rope up tight so anchor canopy wing can't move. Confirm anchor wing wheel is against aluminum wing stops. Center Anchor Knob from side-to-side and mark. Before attaching, make sure anchor rope will be snug when slipped over knob. Screw wing anchor knob into outside girder. Pre-drilling with 1/8" drill bit may be helpful.



11. Pull canopy out using pull handle on lead rope. Fully extend canopy until outside lead wing contacts corner bracket or until canopy cannot extend further.

Follow **Step 10** to position and attach wing anchor knob to outside girder.
